Volunteer would interact with consumers in computer lab located at Wood Lake Campus on Wednesdays from 8:45 to 11:45 a.m. Duties include working with SE Asian customers to locate websites in their language for the first two hours, followed by an hour working with customers of our Day Program to improve their computer skills, understand the Internet, and learn to use email and other skills necessary to keep up-to-date in a computerized society.

Supervision: Volunteers will work directly with the Volunteer Coordinator and are encouraged to ask questions they have about the volunteer opportunity.

Dress or Equipment Needed: Casual dress is acceptable as long as it is neat and clean. Volunteers will be asked to adhere to the agency dress code; a copy of which will be provided. If your shift is around lunch or dinner, please eat prior to your volunteer time. Vending is available.
