Volunteer Driver

Description: Zumbro Valley Mental Health Center, a private 501 (c) (3) organization in southeast Rochester providing mental health and substance use disorder services, needs volunteer drivers to provide transportation for customers of our Recovery Programs. Volunteers will start at 8:00 a.m. at our Wood Lake campus located at 343 Wood Lake Drive SE. Using an agency van the volunteer driver would pick up class participants at their home address and drive them to the Wood Lake campus for services. Volunteers would return to Wood Lake at 11:00 a.m. to provide the customers with rides home.

Drivers are needed Monday through Friday. Volunteers should be adults with excellent driving records. The ideal candidate should read and write at a high school level or above and be able to interact with a wide range of diverse customers.

Supervision: Volunteers will work directly with the Volunteer Coordinator and are encouraged to ask questions they have about the volunteer opportunity.

Dress or Equipment Needed: Casual dress is acceptable as long as it is neat and clean. Volunteers will be asked to adhere to the agency dress code; a copy of which will be provided. If your shift is around lunch or dinner, please eat prior to your volunteer time. Vending is available.
