CO-OCCURRING DISORDER FAMILY GROUP

PURPOSE

The Co-Occurring Disorder Family Group is a new program offered to the families of people experiencing a co-occurring disorder (mental illness and substance use disorder). The program focuses on providing education about co-occurring disorders and their impact on clients and their families. Both families and clients are invited to attend (family is defined as a relative or someone else who has a caring relationship with the client).

Goals for the program include:

- To recognize and build on the strengths of each family member and the family as a unit
- To teach family members about co-occurring substance use and psychiatric disorders and the principles of their treatment
- To reduce relapses, re-hospitalizations and detoxification visits of the family member with the co-occurring disorder
- To reduce stress in the family and improve communication and problem-solving skills
- To help all family members make progress toward personally meaningful goals

Families are required to attend a screening session prior to joining the program.

DIRECTIONS

FROM NORTH

- Take US63 to 7th Street NE
- Turn left onto 7th Street NE
- Drive straight for one block
- Turn left into parking lot

FROM SOUTH

- Take US63 to 7th Street NE
- Turn right onto 7th Street NE
- Drive straight for one block
- Turn left into parking lot

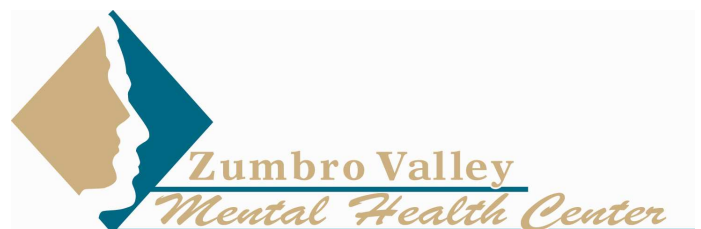
Format

Eight weekly sessions beginning Nov. 4. Meetings held on Thursdays, 6:00 p.m.—8:00 p.m. Ongoing group, so people can join at anytime and receive full eight-week program. Cost is \$160 per family. Limited scholarships available.
